What will the Advanced Practice programme look like?

FIRST 2 SEMESTERS

The first two semesters are the same as the standard Masters.

PENULTIMATE SEMESTER

You will choose between two options:

1. An Internship & Professional Development Project, a 15-week internship at an external company
2. An Applied Consulting Project, which involves working on a live business project in industry

FINAL SEMESTER

You will then complete your final semester, including either a Dissertation or Applied Research Project.
