

Your eVisa


Your Biometric Residence Permit (BRP) which can be used to demonstrate your immigration status, will expire on 31 December 2024.

UK Visas and Immigration (UKVI) are replacing physical documents with an online record of your immigration status. This is known as an eVisa.

An eVisa is an online record of your immigration status and the conditions of your permission to enter or stay in the UK. This is a legal document, and you must complete the necessary steps to access your eVisa as soon as you have been invited to do so by UKVI.

As it is a mandatory requirement, failure to switch to an eVisa by 31 December 2024 may result in your student sponsorship being withdrawn.

You do not have to wait for an invitation from UKVI to access your eVisa. Please switch to your eVisa as soon as possible: [Get access to your eVisa: Overview - GOV.UK \(www.gov.uk\)](#)



What do I need to do now?

To create a UKVI account and access your eVisa you will need:

- Your date of birth
- Your BRP Number
- Your passport (if you do not have a BRP)
- Access to an email address and phone number
- Access to a smartphone

Choose the document you will use to prove your identity. You will also use it to sign in to your account.

- Biometric residence permit (BRP)
Your BRP cannot have expired more than 1 year ago
- Passport
Your passport cannot have expired
