
Setting up MFA (Multifactor Authentication) LAPTOP

Firstly please download the free Microsoft Authenticator app on your mobile phone




Open <u>www.ulster.ac.uk/portal</u> on a laptop or computer

1. Sign in with your <u>@ulster.ac.uk</u> email address and with your password given at the end of Portal registration – cant find it? Go to https://www.ulster.ac.uk/ds/students/banner-student-informationsystem#:~:text=To%20access%20your%20Banner%20Student,with%20your%20 own%20Student%20Record. After you choose Sign in, you'll be prompted for more information.

PLEASE NOTE: do not use your @qahe365.com email address to log in




2. Choose Next.




And press Next.

The following screen will be displayed. Click Next



Click Next again



Then press **Show QR Code**. You'll see a **QR code** that you now need to scan with your phone (see next section)



Scan the QR code through the mobile app

Open the **Authenticator** app on your mobile.



Note – If your phone prompts you to enable access to the camera, or enable notifications,

please click allow.

Click Add Account.

If you can't find the option to add an account, click the button with the **three dots** (Android) or the **+** button (Apple) in the top right corner, then select **Add Account**.

Select Work or school account when prompted.



Choose **Scan a QR code** and using your mobile device camera, **scan** the QR code from your PC/Mac.



Click Next on your PC/Mac.

You'll then receive a notification on your mobile device that you will need to **type** the number you see on screen then press Yes.

- 3. Now go back to your log in page and press done.
- 4. You will then be asked to re-enter your password, enter this and then enter a new password below.

When changing your password, choose a password with a minimum of 12 characters: that includes 3 out of the four categories below.

Upper Case

Lower Case

Digit

Special Character

- 5. You will then be asked to add an additional approval method: your mobile number (SMS) it will ask for your mobile number, then send you an SMS message containing a 6-digit code to verify your device. Type the number you receive into the box
- 6. Once this is done, your MFA will be set up
